Progress Update

Dear Pierce Parents and Caregivers,

This week I'd like to focus on an overview of our progress for the past two weeks, a reminder about upcoming meetings, and a review of some important prior communications.

Progress update:

- Preparations are ongoing at our OLS swing space.
 - Our head custodian and I each walked through two times this past week.
 - Classrooms have been assigned (subject to change as needed)
 - Notes have been posted about where cubbies need to be installed for K-2 and where lockers should be placed for grades 3-5.
 - Surplus lockers have been identified for transfer to our Fisher Hill campus for middle school use.
 - Work order needs have been flagged and will be followed up on.
- Preparations are ongoing at our Fisher Hill swing space.
 - I'll be doing my next walk through with town staff this afternoon, and will report on specific progress next week.
- Bus sign up information has been shared with rising grade 6-8 students. That sign up closes
 on May 6th, after which we will work for finalize and communicate bus assignments, and bus
 schedules. All students who request busing will have access to a bus, however it may not be
 at their preferred time. Reminder that there is no bus to OLS, which is located within the Pierce
 district, one half mile from our current campus.
- Boxes have arrived, and some teachers have already begun packing.
- Parents who signed up to help (see below if you still want to sign up we will gratefully accept your support!) have received emails with options for ways to support. We anticipate that our needs will grow the closer we get to our move out date.
- Beginning next week we will be sharing images of progress updates in each space.
