Progress update:

- <u>OLS</u>
 - The auditorium was fully re-carpeted this week.

- Floor repair work is happening in areas where lockers were removed, in advance of cubbies being installed.
- Fisher Hill
 - Bathroom and other plumbing upgrades are in progress.
 - All the carpet work has been finished. Classrooms that are not carpeted have had tiles repaired as needed. Custodians will wash and wax those floors this summer.
 - On Wednesday I rode the bus with our transportation coordinator. We timed all of our
 prospective routes and will be sharing the bus schedule and bus assignments as soon as
 possible. I am happy to confirm that we will be running a bus from Fisher Hill to OLS every
