A Slice of Pie



March 14th is pi day! To celebrate the number π , this week's Mathlete's Problem of the Week is about the food pie. When you cut pie (or a circle) from one end to the other, you make 2 pieces. When you cut a pie from one end to the other two times, you can make 4 pieces.

- a) What is the most number of pieces you can make with 3 cuts? (Note, your cuts do NOT all need to go through the center of the pie!)
- b) What is the largest number of pieces you can make with 4 cuts?
- c) Is there a pattern here? Can you predict how many pieces you can get from 5 cuts, 6 cuts, or more?
