Here are 9 triangles. Each one has 3 numbers on it. Can arrange these triangles to make a large triangle so that the numbers that touch add up to 10?

**Tip**: you can solve it by having the same colors touch or not touch. **Tip**: you can make a triangle with 4 of the pieces or 10 pieces.
