


Q.2: How helpful are district leaders in providing the support you need to do your job well?




Q.3: How successful are district leaders in communicating important information to staff?

Q.5: Overall, how positive is the working environment in the district as a whole?








Q.1: To what extent do you feel capable of interacting with students at this school who are from a different racial and/or cultural background from your own?




Q.2: When an issue of diversity arises in your class, to what extent do you feel capable of addressing the situation?




Q.3: To what extent do you feel capable of incorporating material about people from different racial or cultural backgrounds into your curriculum?



Q.4: To what extent do you feel capable of having conversations about race with your students?












Q.1: At this school, to what extent are your ideas and suggestions for improvement encouraged?




Q.2: How valuable are the professional development opportunities that are organized by this school (or, for BHS teachers, department)?



Q.3: How valuable are the professional development opportunities that are organized by district staff?




Q.4: How often do your professional development opportunities help you explore new ideas?







Q.2: Overall, how positive is the working environment at this school?




Q.4: To what extent is there a culture of collaboration among educators in their school?






Q.6: How well does this school address matters related to students' socioeconomic status?







Q.7: How well does this school address matters related to students' race/ethnicity?






Q.9: If a friend or colleague were looking for a school to send their children, how likely would you be to recommend this school to them?










Q.1: To what extent are parents/guardians given opportunities to be meaningfully involved at this school?




Q.1: How respectful are this school's leaders towards you?








Q.3: To what extent do you feel supported by this school's leaders?

Q.4: To what extent do you believe this school's leaders will do what they say they will do?








Q.1: How confident are you that you can meet the learning needs of students with disabilities?




Q.2: How confident are you that you can move through material at a pace that works well for each of your students?




Q.3: How effective do you think you are at managing particularly disruptive classes?




Q.4: How confident are you that you can engage students who typically are not motivated?
