WESTBOURNE TER CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

(Bartlett Ter to Beacon St)

Construction begins Wednesday June 19, 2024

Starting June 19, 2024 the Driscoll School contractor, Gilbane Building Company, Inc., will mobilize to **Westbourne Ter** and begin construction. Below please find information regarding the scope of the project, schedule, what to expect, where to get more information and who to contact with questions.

Project Details

- New ADA compliant sidewalks and wheelchair ramps.
- Adding a drop off lane and repaving the road adjacent to the Driscoll School.
- Pavement markings installation including bike lanes on Washington St, Westbourne Ter and Bartlett St

Project Schedule

- Beginning Wednesday June 19, 2024, crews will begin mobilizing to construct sidewalks, driveways, and repave the road.
- Phase 1 during the day Westbourne Ter will be closed from Beacon St to Bartlett Street and only open to local traffic via Westbourne Terrace at Bartlett Street. Parking will be limited and restrictions posted via signage.
- Phase 2 during the day the road will be closed from Bartlett St to 41 Westbourne Ter Local traffic between 41 Westbourne Ter and Beacon will be permitted via the Beacon St at Westbourne Ter intersection. Parking will be limited and restrictions posted via signage.
- Police will be onsite to help with traffic control.
- Roadway signage and striping will be completed before the end of the construction season.

What to expect during construction

- General work hours will be 7 AM to 5 PM, Monday – Friday.
- “No Parking” signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways and/or entryways, the contractor and police details will coordinate access directly with residents and businesses.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- Portions of the street or sidewalk may be closed at various times due to the construction. Police details will be on site to assist with traffic and pedestrians.
